

Admissions FAQs



How do I apply to Linacre College?

The University of Oxford does not permit prospective graduate students to apply directly to colleges. All applications must be submitted via the University's online application form which can be found [here](#), along with some more detailed guidance.

How does College allocation work?

Applications are first considered by the department or faculty responsible for each course of study. If an applicant is successful in securing an offer from their department, they are guaranteed a place at one of Oxford's 44 colleges/halls. All applicants are given the opportunity to indicate a preferred college on their application forms; applicants who do not indicate a college preference are allocated a college by the University.

Applications which state Linacre as their college preference will be sent to the college for consideration as soon as the initial offers are made, giving them the best opportunity to be placed in Linacre, subject to meeting conditions.

How will Linacre make a decision about my application?

Will there be any conditions attached to my offer?

All offers from Linacre are made conditional on evidence being presented that the prospective student has sufficient funds to pay the course fees for the first year of their study. Upon receipt of the financial declaration, we inform the University that the student has met our condition for entry. Once the student has also met any conditions set by the admitting department, the University issues a final unconditional offer letter and contract.

Which courses do Linacre offer?

Linacre College accepts applications to almost all courses and graduate study programmes available within Oxford University. However, there are a handful of courses for which we do not take students. A full list of eligible courses can be found [here](#).

What happens if I need to withdraw?

If you wish to withdraw following application, you will need to notify your department and the college. If you withdraw prior to your course commencing you will not be liable for any fees. If you withdraw after your course has commenced you should liaise closely with the college on your fee liability.
